


# Mt.4:1-16, MK. 1:12-13, Lk. 4:1-13, Jn.1:19-2 NIV



## Across

- 1 Jesus revealed His glory at the wedding in Cana and His disciples put their \_\_\_\_ in Him.
- 2 After the wedding in Cana, leaving Nazareth, Jesus went down to \_\_\_\_ with His family.
- 3 "Here is a true Israelite, in whom there is nothing false"
- 5 The temple that was built under the leadership of \_\_\_\_ after the Babylon exile, was made more glorious than Solomon's temple by Herod. It took 46 years to complete it.
- 8 Jesus' first temple cleansing: Jesus drove all men selling animals, men sitting at the table exchanging money, scattered the money changers' coins, and \_\_\_\_ their tables.
- 10 On Jesus' way to Galilee, He found \_\_\_\_ and asked him to follow Him.
- 11 The first thing that Andrew did after he met Jesus was to tell his brother that he found the \_\_\_\_ and he brought him to Jesus.
- 12 \_\_\_\_ was one of the two disciples of John the Baptist, who followed Jesus and spent a day with Him. The other disciple may be John.
- 13 Jesus called Simon \_\_\_\_ , which translates as "Peter", a "stone".
- 15 in John 1, Jesus was addressed by different names: Word, Light, One and Only Begotten who came from the Father, Jesus Christ, God the One and Only who is at the Father's side, Lamb of God, a man, Son of God, Rabbi, Messiah, Jesus of \_\_\_\_ , Son of Joseph, King of Israel, Son of Man.
- 19 Jesus went to Jerusalem for the \_\_\_\_ festival. This was the first \_\_\_\_ after His baptism.
- 21 Jesus resisted the temptations by using the \_\_\_\_ of God. Satan has no hold on Jesus. He had no sin and He could not sin. 2 Cor. 5:21. The first Adam was tempted the same way (lust of the flesh, lust of the eye, pride of life) but he fell into the temptation.
- 22 \_\_\_\_ and His disciples were invited to the wedding in Cana in Galilee. Mary informed Jesus that they had run out of wine. The presence of Jesus doesn't guarantee the absence of problems but He helps us to overcome or strengthens us to go through it.
- 24 The role of Heaven's angels in Jesus' ministry: They announced His birth, ministered to Him in the wilderness, strengthened Him in Gethsemane, rolled away the tombstone, were present at His ascension, announced His resurrection, and they will accompany Him on His coming.
- 25 Jesus told Nathaniel that he shall see greater things. "You shall see heaven open and the \_\_\_\_ of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man!".

- 1 The significance of the first miracle: The abundance of wine symbolizes the blood Jesus shed for the \_\_\_\_ of sins of many.
- 4 John the Baptist recognized Jesus as the Messiah when the \_\_\_\_ in the form of a dove descended upon Him.
- 6 Philip, Peter, and Andrew were from the town of \_\_\_\_.
- 7 Jesus was tempted by Satan to change stones to bread, to jump off the temple thus the angels would lift Him, and to \_\_\_\_ Satan to receive the kingdoms of this world and their glory.
- 8 When the devil had finished tempting Jesus, he left Him until an \_\_\_\_ time.
- 9 When the priests inquired of who John was he confessed that he was not Christ, \_\_\_\_, or prophet.
- 14 "Everyone serves choice wine first and then the \_\_\_\_ wine after the guests have had too much to drink, but you have saved the best till now." The ordinary water changed into extraordinary wine when the servants obeyed Jesus.
- 16 Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil for 40 days and nights without eating. He was with the wild \_\_\_\_ and angels attended Him.
- 17 Many believed in Jesus after they saw the miraculous sign but Jesus would not \_\_\_\_ himself to them because He knew what is in a man.
- 18 Before Jesus began the public ministry, John testified about Him, "Look, the lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the \_\_\_\_". Centuries before Isaac had asked, "Where is the lamb for burnt offering?"
- 20 Jews demanded a sign of His authority to cleanse the temple. Jesus answered, "Destroy this temple, and I will raise it again in \_\_\_\_ days". Jesus' prediction about His death and resurrection.
- 23 Jesus asked the servants to fill \_\_\_\_ jars (holds 20 to 30 G) with water and take it to the master of the banquet.
