- 5 The four faces in the vision may prefigure the presentation of Christ in the four gospels. Namely, as a lion(king), the Messiah in \_\_, as an ox the Servant in Mark, as a Perfect Man in Luke, and as an eagle the Mighty God in John. These faces pointing to the North, S, W, and E shows the universality of the gospel.
- 7 When Ezekiel was \_\_ years old while he was among the exiles by the Kebar River, he saw visions of God.
- 10 As Elijah and Elisha were talking, a chariot of fire appeared and separated them and Elijah went up to heaven in a \_\_. [2Ki.2:11]. Also see Job 38:1
- 11 Of all the old Testament prophets, only Ezekiel saw that the heavens were opened. In the New Testament, the heaven was opened unto Jesus, \_\_ and John the apostle.
- 13 The \_\_ of the living creatures was in the wheel and it gave directions to the wheel. The mobility of the wheels probably suggests the omnipresence of God; the eyes, His omniscience; and the height of the rim, His omnipotence.
- 14 Ezekiel's contemporary prophets were Daniel and \_\_.
- 21 Before Christ's first coming, the Spirit did not indwell all believers as now, the spirit of the Lord came upon the people the Lord had called for a special mission. Some examples are, 70 elders that Moses appointed, \_\_, Balaam, Gideon, Samson, Saul, David...Jdg.3:10
- 22 In 605 B.C, Jerusalem was attacked and Daniel and other captives were taken to Babylon. In 597 B.C (second phase of attack) temple treasures and more captives were taken including Ezekiel and \_\_ [2Ki.24:15]. In 587(third phase), Jerusalem was destroyed and almost everyone was taken to exile.
- 23 In Isaiah's vision, he saw the Lord seated on a throne and above Him were \_\_ each with six wings. They fly above God's throne and their primary duty is to praise God constantly.
- 26 The words of lament and \_\_ and woe were written on both sides of the scroll.
- 27 Another appearance of Cherubim is in the garden of Eden to keep adam from the \_\_.
- 29 In Ez.3:24-27, The Lord was further training Ezekiel to be used as a mouthpiece for God as He would direct him to speak or to be \_\_ not rebuking the rebellious.
- 30 Though the Israelites' rejection might sting like briars, thorns and \_\_, the Lord warned Ezekiel not to rebel like them.

- 1 When Ezekiel saw the glory of God, he fell \_\_ (right response) and he heard the voice of one speaking.
- 2 \_\_ was obedient to God, he opened his mouth and the Lord filled it. God's messenger must first absorb God's truth before he preaches.
- 3 Psalm 137 describes the beginning of the captivity period. "By the rivers of \_\_ we sat and wept when we remembered Zion". Psalm 126 describes the end of this stage.
- 4 According to Num.4:3 men entered the priestly service at the age of thirty years. \_\_ began his ministry when he was thirty years old. Luke 3:23
- 6 Ezekiel son of Buzi was a prophet and \_\_.
- 8 The living creatures covered their body with two \_\_ show their reverence in God's presence. The other two spread upward symbolic of rising above the troubles.
- 9 After the vision of the Lord, Ezekiel went in \_\_ (probably thinking about the stubbornness of His people) and sat Tel Abib among his people for seven days. The 7 days may be significant because he may have regarded this as the preparation for his ordination to a prophetic priesthood. Lev.8:33
- 12 When the spirit came into Ezekiel, he stood up. The Lord commissioned him to speak to the stubborn Israelites whether they would listen or not, for they would know that a \_\_ had been among them.
- 15 Another person who ate the scroll given by an angel is mentioned in Rev.10:10.
- 16 After the seven days of silence, the Lord made Ezekiel a \_\_ for the house of Israel to warn them to turn away from their evil ways. If he didn't warn them, the Lord would hold him accountable for their blood.
- 17 The word of God was sweet as \_\_ in Ezekiel's mouth.
- 18 Prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the \_\_. 2Pe.1:21.
- 19 One interpretation of the four faces is that it represent all His creation. Man is the crown of creation; lion,ox and \_\_ dominate the wild animal kingdom, domestic animals and skies respectively. All of His creations are subject to the man sitting above the throne.
- 20 Another heavenly being mentioned in Rev.4:6-8 the 'four living \_\_', which have features in common with both the Seraphim and Cherubim.
- 24 The four living creatures in Ezekiel's vision are identified as \_\_ in Eze.10:20. They are exalted angelic being, who constantly attend the throne of God.
- 25 In the \_\_ year of the exile of Ezekiel the word of the Lord came to him and the hand of the Lord was upon him to strengthen him for the prophetic work.. Ezekiel means 'God strengthens'
- 28 Ezekiel's vision of the throne chariot: An immense cloud with flashing lightning surrounded by brilliant light. At the center of the fire, there were four living creatures each with four faces and four wings. Under their wings had the hands of a man and their feet looked like that of a calf. Beside each creature, there was a wheel. Above the heads, there was an expanse and above the expanse, there was a throne of sapphire and above that was a figure that looked like a man surrounded with brilliant light. This was the appearance of the \_\_ of the Lord.
